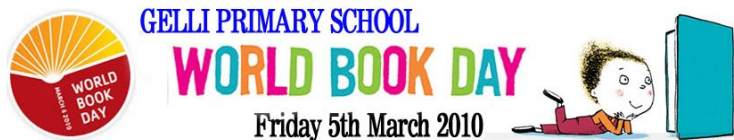
St David's Day Concerts
