Strategy Actions

Establishing the initiative

- LEA Out of hours learning co-ordinator Nicola Cornwall to brief staff during staff meeting on Children's University and Kid's College initiative.
- Link initiative to our existing after school provision and PESS initiative.
- Identify further opportunities to enrich provision from nursery to year 6.
- Extend provision through networking with Treorchy Comprehensive School E3 Co-ordinator providing additional outreach activities.
- Parents informed by letter and information published on the school website.

Registration and Accreditation

- Timetables of clubs and permission letters distributed to children.
- All clubs and groups registered with LEA Out of hours learning co-ordinator and administrator.
- Registers taken at the beginning of each session.
- Registers sent to Admin team at Ty Trevithick termly.
- Accreditation feedback received and notification of awards updated periodically.
- Awards assembly organised in conjunction with admin team when appropriate.

Outcome Measures

- Staff, parents and children fully aware of initiative.
- Timetable of out of hours provision achieved.
- Outreach programme with Treorchy Comprehensive School established.
- Gelli Primary School is a satellite school.
- Timetable of clubs runs effectively.
- Children receive accreditation and qualify for awards.
- Accreditation awards assembly organised and awards presented.
- Initiative advertised to the wider community via school website and local media.
